

But it all began with one man in an ancient city.



LESSONS IN ABRAHAM'S LIFE

Abram's Fear or Doubt	Abram's Lesson	God's Faithful Action
Fear of Pharaoh, so he lied about the identity of his wife (Gen. 12:10–20)	"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble" (Ps. 46:1)	"The LORD inflicted serious diseases on Pharaoh and his household because of Abram's wife Sarai" (Gen. 12:17).
Doubts of God's power to give him a son (Gen. 17:15–19)	"With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible" (Matt. 19:26).	"Now the LORD was gracious to Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did for Sarah what he had promised. Sarah became pregnant and bore a son to Abraham in his old age, at the very time God had promised him" (Gen. 21:1–2).
Fear of Abimelek, so he lied about the identity of his wife (Gen. 20:1–18)	"My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge. Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge" (Ps. 62:7–8).	"God came to Abimelek in a dream one night and said to him, 'You are as good as dead because of the woman you have taken; she is a married woman'" (Gen. 20:3).
