

*Can hope come from Satan? Like if you feel like God is saying "no" but you still feel tons of hope in it and you can't let go? Like a career path or relationship? Is it possible that Satan can feed us hope, or is that our flesh and something ungodly?*

Satan is devoid of hope (Pr 14:12, Jn 10:10); but, God can be one's hope (Ps 39:7, Jn 10:10).

It is possible for one to wish for a thing which God does not want for him (Ac 24:26).

To know God's will one must maintain a close relationships with him. Know his word (Ps 119:105), pray for direction (Ex 33:13) and wait on him (Ps 27:14).

A life spent remembering God (Deut 8:2) and walking in his ways (Deut 8:6) leads to answered prayer (Eph 3:20).

God is delighted to: order the steps of a good man (Ps 37:23), lead (Ps 139:24), teach (Ps 25:9, 12) and make himself known to him (Ps 103:7).

Whereas man's way is darkness (Pr 2:13); God's way leads to blessing (Pr 8:32).

When one: acknowledges God (Pr 3:6), commits to him (Ps 37:5) and keeps his precepts and testimonies (Ps 119:168), he can hear his lovingkindness.
