

Jesus and the Father are one. How are Christ's ways his Father's ways?

Jesus' ways and his Father's ways are the same. God is triune (Ge 1:1–3, 26).

Philip asked Jesus, "Lord, show us the Father and we will be satisfied (Jn 14:8)."

Jesus answered: Anyone who has seen him has seen the Father (v. 9). Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in him (v. 10).

God's ways are: right (Hos 14:9), just (Da 4:37), true (Re 15:3), higher than man's (Is 55:8, 9) and unsearchable (Ro 11:33).¹

God's ways are not man's ways (Is 55:6–9).
