*Is it heresy for a Christian to be tolerant of the LGBT Movement?* 

Heresy is teaching that which is contrary to the truth. Churches should teach that sex outside of the covenant of marriage is forbidden (Ex 20:14).

Churches may welcome unrepentant sexual sinners (Ge 13:13, Ex 20:14, Jas 4:8) whether heterosexual Lev 20:10–12 or homosexual (Le 20:10,13); but, they should not call them Christians (1 Pe 2:5). Habitual sinners must be warned that they are not saved and they will not inherit the kingdom of God (1 Co 6:9-10).

When a Christian sins and will not repent, church discipline in in order as outlined in Matthew chapter 18 verses 15–20.

Whereas compromised churches (2 Thess 2:3) are part of the great harlot of the Book of Revelation (Re 17:1–18); the true church is salt (Mt 5:13) and light (vv. 14–16) seeking Jesus' interests and remaining true to him (Phil 2:20).

God's truth must be shared with gentleness and respect (1 Pe 3:15-16). The Lord will forgive any sin committed because he died for all sin (Ro 5:8). The Holy Spirit works to regenerate the sinner (Jn 16:8–11). If one continues to sin against the Holy Spirit, there is no forgiveness for him (Mt 12:31, 32).
