When did Arphaxad die?

According to the Bible Arphaxad died at the age of 438 (Ge 11:10-13, 1 Chron 1:17-18, Lk 3:36).

Arphaxad, son of Shem (Ge 10:22, 24) and an ancestor of Christ (Lk 3:36) is also mentioned in the book of Judith as ruler of the Medes who rebuilt the wall of Ecbatana before being attacked by Nebuchadnezzar (Judith 1:1-6).¹

Henry Morris wrote:

Little is known of Arphaxad except that he was in the direct line leading to Abraham. A region known as Arrapachitis in Assyria may stem from his name....²
