...What about modern dreamers on TV programs?

Some programs discusses: dreams, visions (Joe 2:28) and the Nephilim (Ge 6:4) citing non-canonical books such as The Book of Enoch or the Book of Jasher. Men conjecture; but, students of the Word should test all truth claims (Ac 17:11).

God can speak to us in dreams (Ge 37:5). In the night we can gain: insight, wisdom and warning. Sensationalism (Mt 8:4, Mk 1:45; Lk 5:15-16) and superstition (Ac 17:22); however, are frowned upon in scripture. Discernment is necessary (1 Jn 4:1-5).

God gives spiritual gifts (Ro 12:6–8; 1 Co 12:4–30) and the Spirit continues to move in the world today (Jn 3:8, Ro 8:14). He teaches (Jn 14:26) primarily thought his Word and convicts men of sin (Jn 16:8–11).

One would do well to maintain a good conscience (Ac 23:1) so that is does not become dead (Pr30:20) and subsequently seared (1 Ti 4:2).
